

Judith Gruszynske Memorial Scholarship

The Judith Gruszynske Memorial Scholarship is offered in memory of Judith "Judie" Gruszynske, a lifelong 4-H member and leader.

One \$500 scholarship will be awarded. Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Student must have been a 4-H member for at least 5 years
- Student must have exhibited at the fair
- Student must have displayed an active leadership role
- Student must maintain a 2.0 or higher after their first semester of college
- Student must attend a college, technical college, university or educational training program either full time or part time
- Tuition costs must be at least \$250 to receive the entire scholarship
- Scholarship is non-renewable

The scholarship will be awarded after the recipient successfully completes a program of study, or one full semester post-high school. "Successfully completes" is defined as achieving a 2.0 ("C") or higher.

The program of study must be started within a year after receiving the award. The student is required to submit the grade report to the 4-H office within 60 days after completing the program of study or completing the first semester of school. Failure to do so in a timely manner will result in loss of scholarship funds. The recipient may also be asked for proof of program cost.
