Color-Brave Photo Gallery: Black and Brown Faces	To create a traveling exhibition of portraits and stories of black and brown faces of people in Oshkosh with the goals of: shifting some common, community-wide stereotypes, celebrating black and brown residents, and improving the overall educational and economic success of the community.	7,500
Goodwill Industries of North Central Wisconsin	Neighbor Ed	To facilitate neighbor-to-neighbor education, strengthen relationships, and bolster neighborhood pride in the River East Neighborhood of Oshkosh.	15,625
Reach Counseling Services	Winnebago County Social Media Intervention Program	To pilot a social media intervention/diversion program with Neenah youth, who could otherwise face legal consequences for recent social media behaviors. Monies would cover the Winnebago County diversion fee of \$100/person for youth from low income families.	5,000
Winnebago County Literacy Council	English Language Learning (ELL) Family Literacy	To help refugee parents attending Family Literacy classes provide stimulating learning activities for their children from infancy to age 5 in order to increase school readiness.	5,550
World Relief Fox Valley	Immigration Legal Services Program	To expand Immigration Legal Services to help local refugees apply for Lawful Permanent Residence or "Green Cards," as required by law, and for citizenship after five years of residence.	20,000
