Affiliate Funds are endowments that are housed at the Oshkosh Area Community Foundation, but serve specific geographic regions within the scope of the Foundation. Each Affiliate Fund represents a region and/or population group and is represented by an advisory committee of residents from that region. Advisory committee members raise resources for the endowment and recommend distributions from the endowment for charitable causes within that region. Affiliate Fund Board of Directors partner with the Foundation to maximize earnings, secure principal and minimize administrative costs.

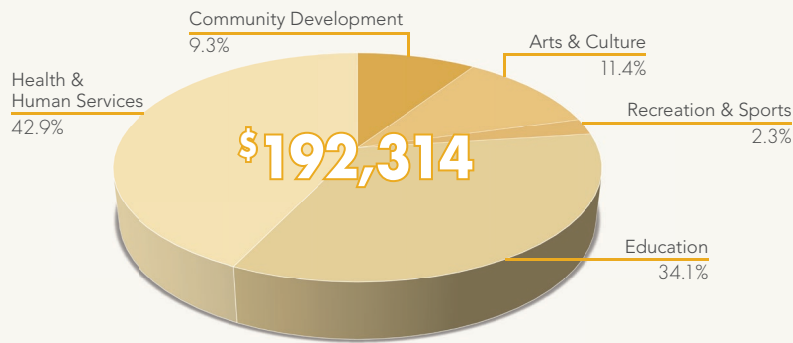

Grants awarded by the Foundation in various program areas between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

Overview: Founded in 2000, the Green Lake County/Ripon Community Foundation distributed \$192,314 in grants to 38 organizations during FY2016, supporting programs in education, health, human services, arts, recreation, historic preservation and civic endeavors. More than \$33,930 in scholarships and grants were awarded to support students and educators.

Areas Served: Green Lake County, including the communities within the public school district boundaries of Berlin, Green Lake, Markesan, Princeton and Ripon (Fond du Lac County) school districts.

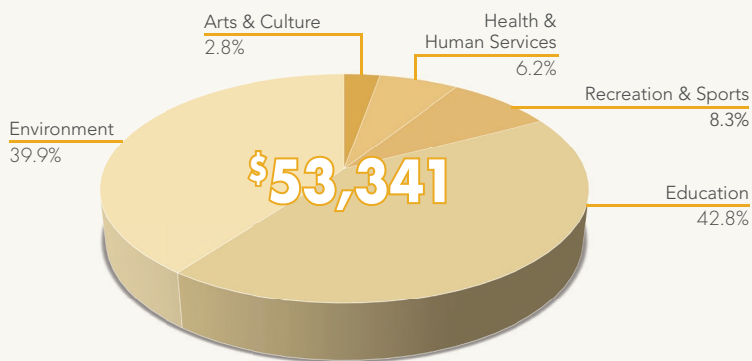

Grants awarded by the Foundation in various program areas between July 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016.

Overview: The Winneconne Area Community Foundation was founded in 2013 as a vehicle for donors to support causes, projects or endeavors that benefit the Winneconne area. The Foundation provided \$53,341 in grants and scholarships to 26 charitable community organizations, educational institutions and government agencies during FY2016. More than \$22,700 in scholarships and grants were awarded to support students and educators.

Area Served: Winneconne Area School District, which includes the Village of Winneconne and towns of Larsen, Winchester, Poygan and Butte des Morts.

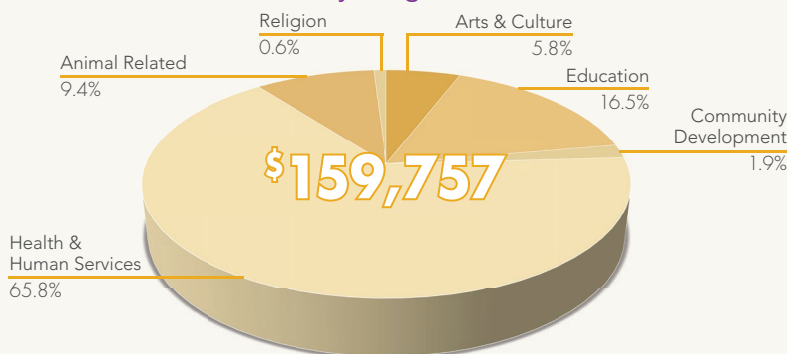

Overview: Founded in 1998, the Women's Fund is a partnership of donors, grantees and volunteers working to advance the status of women of all ages in Winnebago County, Wisconsin. The Women's Fund awarded \$159,757 in grants and scholarships during FY2016 to 45 charitable organizations, education institutions and government agencies. The Fund works to increase literacy, prevent violence, promote economic self-sufficiency, improve physical and emotional health, teach leadership and encourage personal growth for women of all ages.
