Boys & Girls Club of the Tri-County Area	Unmet Needs and Mentoring Program	To partner with Green Lake Health & Human Services to provide youth with basic needs such as showers, laundry, food, shoes, clothing, medical/dental care, emergency needs, school supplies and holidays; and help support a mentoring program for youth in grades 3-12.	30,000
Christine Ann Domestic Abuse Services, Inc.	Help is Here Fund	To remove barriers for approx. 27 domestic abuse victims from Green Lake County to achieving independence and safety like purchasing birth records, bus tickets, gas, work clothes, rental assistance, medications, new door locks, vehicle maintenance and job training.	10,000
Green Lake County Health and Human Services	Diapers - Children + Families Unit	To provide diapers and baby wipes for parents/guardians of infants and toddlers in need that are actively involved with Child Welfare, Child Protective Services, Birth to Three or Economic Support.	1,990
Green Lake County Health and Human Services	Flexible Funds - Children + Families Unit	To provide flexible funding for basic needs assistance to parents/caregivers and children that are actively involved with Child Welfare, Child Protective Services or the Youth Justice system when other resources have been exhausted or are otherwise unavailable.	5,000
Green Lake County Health and Human Services	Food Pantry + Homebound Nutrition Program	To purchase canned goods, vegetables, fruit and cereal from local grocery stores for distribution at the Green Lake County Food Pantry (\$10,000) and hot meals to be delivered to homebound individuals age 60+ (\$5,000).	15,000

Green Lake School District	Essential Needs Closet	To provide essential clothing and hygiene items as well as snacks for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch.	3,000
Lutheran Counseling & Family Services of Wisconsin	Special Times of Need Counseling Program	To offer professional counseling services to those in the Green Lake County area who find themselves in crisis due to mental illness or addiction and are uninsured, underinsured or unable to make payment.	3,000
Markesan District Schools	Weekend Food Program	To start a new program providing approx. 100 elementary school students with nutritious and easy to prepare food for the weekends on a bi-weekly basis.	7,000
Markesan Resident Home	Resident Services	To purchase a recumbent cross trainer, a trishaw, virtual reality headsets and a bladder scanner.	11,500
Princeton, City of	Christmas for the Young and Old	To take ten underprivileged children from the City of Princeton shopping locally for their families for Christmas and host lunch for 8-10 widowed or isolated older adults.	800
Princeton Senior Citizens Club, Inc.	Unisex Handicap Bathroom	To help cover the cost of labor and supplies to create a new bathroom with wheelchair access.	4,900
