Community Resource Team	To help fund the salaries of four bilingual and bicultural Community Resource Specialists to better provide responsive and equitable services to approximately 150 clients in Waushara County in seven focus areas: job skills and economic security, business coaching and lending, community and real estate development, housing and transportation, child and family development, health/wellness and safety, and advocacy and community engagement.	10,000
CATALPA HEALTH	Psychiatry Access for Kids + Teens	To ensure more than 1,200 kids and teens have access to psychiatrists and Advanced Practice Nurse Prescribers, who can assess, prescribe, and monitor their mental health medication needs.	20,000
CHILD CARE RESOURCE & REFERRAL	Early Childhood Support Services Coordinator	To help fund early childhood support services reaching 80 childcare programs in Winnebago and Green Lake Counties, which aid childcare staff in developing positive guidance techniques and reducing challenging behaviors, adapting classroom and home environments to meet children's developmental needs, accessing developmentally appropriate training and curriculum, and making family referrals to community partners for additional support.	5,225

COVEY	Just Talk About It - Healthy and Safe Relationships	To pilot "Just Talk About It," a healthy and safe relationships program, throughout Winnebago County serving approximately 60 youth and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, their families, and 40-50 professionals who support them like educators, direct service professionals, and crisis intervention specialists.	10,000
DAY BY DAY SHELTER	Day By Day Guest Employment Program	To support four 10 hour per week, entry-level jobs at the Shelter to be filled by guests who are experiencing homelessness, allowing the individuals to gain work experience, part-time income, and a sense of purpose that will lead them to independence and self-sufficiency.	10,000
DAY BY DAY SHELTER	Tablet + Scanner for Guest Check-in	To purchase an iPad and bluetooth scanner to speed up the nightly check-in process for guests, who will each be assigned a unique barcode, and reduce stress on staff.	1,169
JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF WISCONSIN	New Tablets for JA Finance Park + BizTown	To purchase approximately 12 tablets to provide Finance Park and BizTown financial literacy education to young people at the JA Capstone Center in Appleton.	5,000
MIRAVIDA LIVING	From a Blood Draw to a Finger Prick	To purchase 5 Coag-Sense PT2 INR Pro Meters with test strip kits to be able to draw blood with a simple prick to the finger in order to check residents' therapeutic INR levels and determine if adjustments are needed to their medication doses.	3,328
NAMI OSHKOSH	TV for Hybrid Support Group Meetings	To purchase a large television and wall mount so that people can continue to attend support group meetings via Zoom.	1,787
NOVA COUNSELING	Desktop Computer	To purchase a desktop computer to better interace with the security camera system.	1,800
OSHKOSH AREA COMMUNITY PANTRY	Freezer Condenser Replacement	To replace the condenser unit that controls two walk-in freezers that are vital to the success of maintaining proper temperature for frozen product including vegetables, meals, pizzas and meat.	6,800
OSHKOSH AREA HUMANE SOCIETY	Donor Software	To support the purchase and migration to new donor management software.	5,000
OSHKOSH COMMUNITY YMCA	Expansion of Childcare - UW Oshkosh Facility	To offset some of the financial burden associated with opening a new childcare program in the former UW Oshkosh Children's Learning and Care Center (CLCC), which will help the 32 families impacted by UW O's closure of the CLCC as well as an additional 80-106 children and families in the community.	20,000

REACH COUNSELING SERVICES	Counseling + Support Staff Expansion	To add two full-time therapists and one full-time front desk representative to adequately meet the demand for short-term, crisis-based counseling and case management, as well as long-term counseling for sexual assault survivors and their families.	15,000
RIPON PUBLIC LIBRARY	Meeting Owl + Laptop	To purchase a Meeting Owl and laptop for use in the library's meeting rooms and to provide remote access to library programs for those who are unable to attend in person for whatever reason.	2,950
SAMARITAN	Wellness Screen Clinicians	To add two Wellness Screen clinicians to meet the increasing mental health needs of students in a timelier manner, allow for smaller caseloads, engage with families more frequently, and reduce the fatigue current staff are experiencing.	20,000
SOLUTIONS RECOVERY	Recovery Center Addition Tables + Chairs	To purchase approximately 26 tables and 80 chairs for use by participants attending recovery meetings and services in the more functional, welcoming, and inclusive meeting space created by the Recovery Center Addition project.	5,000
WINNEBAGO AREA LITERACY COUNCIL	Program Services Expansion	To supplement operations at the Oshkosh Public Library by leasing approximately 1,700 square feet of space to house offices for five staff, two tutoring rooms, and two additional classroom spaces in order to meet growing demand for services and staff expansion.	10,000
